

Join us this May and June as we dance, discuss, and discover - together.





Citizens and Citizening

How do we cope with climate change?



Welcome to the fourth edition of "Ahmedabad, parlons!".

This time, we've chosen to focus on what's on everyone's mind every 5th of June: protecting the environment. But instead of limiting ourselves to symbolic acts like planting trees, we want to highlight everyday actions that citizens can take to make our cities more sustainable and livable. Urban areas are responsible for nearly 70% of global carbon emissions, with transport and buildings being the biggest contributors. Yet, the harshest impacts are felt by rural farmers and coastal fishing communities.

The onus thus falls on the urbane to make a difference as the perpetrators, if one might use the term, of climate change. A lot of the narrative around climate change focuses on industries and fossil fuel lobbies. From fast fashion to food flown halfway across the world to satisfy elite tastes—whether it's coffee or avocados—it is largely the affluent who drive excessive consumption. Yet, because they have greater platforms, they are also the ones most often heard in conversations about climate action. Meanwhile, poorer consumers, who typically have a much smaller carbon footprint, remain unheard—busy walking to work, with little space to voice their concerns.

In a world where the burden of environmental harm falls disproportionately on the most vulnerable, how can we, as citizens, take meaningful action to green our surroundings and restore water bodies—before placing demands on others for climate action? This is the question we aim to explore together, as we discuss the impact of climate change on the poorest communities and highlight the responsibility of those with greater resources to lead the way in reducing that impact.




